Islam's Messenger Did not Know if He would be in Paradise:

Say, "I am not something new among the messengers, nor do I **know what will be done with me or with you**. I only follow that which is revealed to me, and I am not but a clear warner." (Quran 46:9).

'O Allah's Messenger (ﷺ)! Let my father be sacrificed for you! On whom else shall Allah bestow His honor?' The Prophet (ﷺ) said, 'No doubt, death came to him. By Allah, I too wish him good, but **by Allah, I do not know what Allah will do with me though I am Allah's Messenger** (ﷺ)' (Sahih al-Bukhari 1243)

What did Muhammad say about his Own Sinfulness?

Narrated Abu Huraira:

I heard Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) saying." By Allah! I ask for forgiveness from Allah and turn to Him in repentance more than seventy times a day." Sahih al-Bukhari 6307

What Does the Quran Say about Jesus?

"He said: I am only a messenger of thy Lord, that I may bestow on thee a faultless son" (Quran 19:19).

The Quran and Bible both agree that Jesus was sinless.

The Quran says no bearer of sins can bear the sin of another (Quran 6:164), but Jesus could because he had no sins to bear. He was sinless.

Jesus:

"Peace be upon me the day I was born, the day I die, and the day I am raised alive"
(Quran 19:33).

وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَيَّ يَوْمَ وُلِدْتُ وَيَوْمَ أَمُوتُ وَيَوْمَ أُبْعَثُ حَيًّا

Jesus went to the cross to pay for our sins. He took up himself willingly the justice and wrath our sins deserve. He did this out of his extraordinary love for us.



Look what Jesus did for You:

"For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person— though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die— but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.

For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life. More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation" (Romans 5:6-11)
